GOLF COURSE RULES:

Golf Canada rules shall govern all play

Local Rules:

- this is a soft spike facility only
- please repair your ball mark & one other
- please rake bunkers & replace your divots
- no more than four players to a group
- we expect all groups to finish 9 holes in under 2 hours
- all players must check into pro shop before starting their back nine
- every player is required to have their own set of clubs
- LCB provincial rules state that no one is permitted to bring or consume alcohol not purchased at this facility whether in the clubhouse or on the golf course

Hazards :

- Lateral water hazards -defined by red stakes or lines
- Water hazards -defined by yellow stakes or lines
- Ground Under Repair -defined by signs and lines
- area deemed unplayable due to ongoing golf course work
- Out of Bounds -defined by white stakes, lines or property boundaries
- Immoveable Obstructions: staked trees, sprinkler heads, irrigation control boxes, signs, cart or maintenance paths- drop within 1 club length of nearest point of relief--no closer to hole with no penalty
